EXAMINATION—Continued.

General Debility: He presents all the effects of advancing age. His back is bent, and his movements are slow and feeble. His muscles are flabby and have lost their elasticity. He has no organic disease, but he is unable to perform any manual labor.

Dyspepsia: All digestive organs normal in size and function. He has no abdominal soreness. He is in good physical condition. He has no symptoms of dyspepsia.

Piles: He has no piles. No fissure, prolapse, fistula or stricture. His rectal mucous membrane is normal.

No other disability found to exist. Chest symmetrical; expiration 29, rest 40, inspiration 42.

He presents no evidence of syphilitic infection or other vicious habits.

We find that the aggregate permanent disability for earning a support by manual labor is due to Fracture of Left Leg and General Debility, not due to vicious habits, and warrants a rating of \$12.00.
