BASIS OF CLAIM.

Injury of back - incurred at Point of Rocks, Va. September 20, 1864. Caused by a tree falling upon him while carrying timber to build barracks. Also while on detached service in Ambulance Corps and washing wagons in a lake near Rio Grande River, Texas, incurred injury of left foot by stepping on glass. Filed July 8 1893. Contracted Vertigo, disease of back at Brownsville, Texas the last of 1865 or early part of 1866. Also sprained his back while moving dead bodies in front of Petersburg in the winter of 1864. Also contracted gravel and throat trouble from exposure and cut his right foot on a piece of glass while engaged at washing
