 was there kept around the house a long
 while. I do not now remember
 that claimant has complained
 of his back, spine or head at any time
 since he came from the Army. I do
 not write my name, but I did
 make an affidavit in this case
 at one time I believe. The affidavit
 you have read as usual is probably
 right, but I do not remember now
 what I there stated, as my memory
 is not now good. I am not
 related to the claimant or interested
 in the success of his claim. I fully
 understand and comprehend the
 questions asked me and my
 answers have been correctly
 recorded.
