Case of James W. Pindney, No. 390660

On this 11th day of February, 1888, at Baltimore, County of _____, State of MD, before me, Henry A. Paul, a Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared William H. Stevens, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him during this Special Examination of aforesaid pension claim, deposes and says:

My name is William H. Stevens, my age is 44 years, residence and post office address 1623 Vincent Alley, Baltimore MD and I am a laborer. I have resided in the city since 1867. I was a private in A. B. 19th Regt U.S. G. I. from Dec 7, 1863 until Jan. 15, 1867. I was with the Co. at Camp Belger this city but did not go to Hager's Ferry on the regular expedition that went from Bre and I did not go with the company to Sumner's Md at least it should be front as I was sick at that time. I do not remember any man by the name of James W. Pindney in our company at any time. There was a Jacob Pindney in the company. I fully understand the questions asked me and my answers have been correctly recorded.
