

DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

TO BE EXECUTED BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR SOME OFFICER THEREOF HAVING CUSTODY OF ITS SEAL.

On this 26th day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight personally appeared before me, J. B. Clark of the Superior Court, a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, James M. Pinkney aged 58 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore, county of Baltimore, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical James M. Pinkney who was ENROLLED on the first day of March, 1864, in Company B of the 19th Regiment of M. S. C. B. commanded by ... and was honorably DISCHARGED at McKim Hospital Baltimore Md on the 25th day of May, 1865; that his personal description is as follows: Age, ... years; height ... feet ... inches; complexion, ...; hair, ...; eyes, ...

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Annapolis, in the State of Maryland on or about the 10th day of April, 1864, he contracted a fever which was called typhoid from the effects of which he has never recovered entirely which said espasms was in the line of duty

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: at McKim Hospital Baltimore Md of treatment.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been that of a Janitor. That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a Porter. That he is now disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, A. D. Evans of 26 W. Calvert St Baltimore Md, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has not received nor applied for a Pension. That his Post Office Address is 110 W. Spring St county of Baltimore State of Maryland.
