

# A Declaration for Original Pension of an Invalid. A

On this 1<sup>st</sup> day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy two, personally appeared before me a Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court, the same being a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, James Tyler aged 27 years, a resident of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is <sup>not</sup> married; that his wife's name was \_\_\_\_\_, to whom he was married at \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 18\_\_\_\_, that he is the identical James B. Tyler, who I enlisted in Captain J. Murray Hoage Company \_\_\_\_\_ Regiment, 4<sup>th</sup> Brigade, 3<sup>rd</sup> Division at Baltimore Maryland, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1864, and was honorably discharged at Washington Dc on the fourth day of May, 1866 that his personal description is as follows: Age, 27 years; height, 5- feet 9 inches; complexion, Black; hair, Black; eyes, Black; that while in the service aforesaid, and in the line of his duty, he received the following disability, to wit: 2. at the Battle of Petersburg Virginia on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 1864, while charging the enemy, he was wounded in the right elbow. was treated in City Point Hospital Virginia, and at a Hospital in Newark New Jersey. remained at first named hospital three weeks. was also at Macom House Hospital <sup>Roxana Va</sup> Virginia five weeks that since leaving the said service, this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been light-labor, that prior to his entry into the service above-named, he was a man of good sound physical health, being when entered, a Brick maker

that now he is Totally disabled from obtaining his subsistence from manual labor in consequence of his above-named injuries received in the service of the United States; that he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States by reason of the disabilities above stated; that he hereby appoints Hugh M. Eldery Baltimore Md his Attorney to prosecute his claim; that he has never received \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ applied for a pension; that his Post Office is at Baltimore, County of Baltimore, State of Maryland; that his domicile or place of abode is House No 87 Plumt alley, between Howard & Hill streets.
