strong, healthy man, that he came back on crutches
after the war, and attempted to resume his old place
but had to be discharged, as he was entirely unable to
work, affiant is still in the same establishment which
is that of D. F. Haynes & Co 347 N. Baltimore St. Quensmore
Merchants, the business is a very heavy one, requiring
a strong man to handle it, and before the war there was
no stronger or better workman than the claimant Isaac H.
Baker
