

*WIDOW'S ARMY PENSION.

On this 30th day of January A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty - six personally appeared before me Alford Mace Clerk, of the Superior Court, Mrs. Elizabeth Sushy, a resident of No. 1 Madison Alley in the County of Baltimore State of Maryland, aged (33) years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the Act of Congress approved July 14, 1862: That she is the widow of Samuel Sushy who was a Private in Company X commanded by Capt. Z. Wilbur in the Fourth (4th) Regiment of U. S. Col. Troops commanded by Colonel Duncan of North Carolina in the war of 1861, who died on the 5th day of October 1865, at Post Hospital in the County of New Berne, State of North Carolina that his death was caused by disease. She further declares that she was married to the said Samuel Sushy on the 29th day of May 1856, at Baltimore, Md. by Rev. Phillip Scott a Minister; that her husband, the aforesaid Samuel Sushy died on the day above mentioned, and that she has remained a widow ever since that period, as will more fully appear by reference to the proof hereto annexed. She also declares that she has not in any manner been engaged in, or aided or abetted the rebellion in the United States. And she further states that she believes there is no public record of her said marriage, and there is a private or family record, and the best evidence she is able to procure of her marriage is an extract from the family record in her family bible.

That the names and ages of her children under sixteen years of age at her husband's decease, and the place of residence, is as follows: Samuel Thomas Sushy, aged (9) years, Frances Amelia Sushy, aged (7) years, and Emanuel Sushy, aged (5) years. Samuel was born on 14th of January, 1857, Frances Amelia, on the 29th of May, 1859, and Emanuel, on the 21st April, 1861.

She hereby appoints R. B. Gustin, No. 15 S. Gay St, Balto. her Attorney, with power of substitution, to prosecute her claim and receive the certificate when issued.
