appeared John T. Brown, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him, deposes and says I am 54 years old and am by occupation a laborer My P.O. address is 800 N. Spring St Baltimore Md. Yes sir I know Isaac Johnson and have known him ever since 1866. When I got acquainted with him he was kind or bluish but I don't know how to describe the condition of his eyes. He just "groped." No he did not have rheumatism when I first got acquainted with him. I can't say how many years he has had rheumatism. I know he has had rheumatism for several years and know he was confined to his bed helpless not more than two years ago. I can't tell you at all even approximately when I first noticed that he had rheumatism. I can't tell whether I first noticed that he had rheumatism five ten or fifteen years after the war or when it was. I just can't remember further than that he has had rheumatism a number of years and his eyes have been affected ever since I got acquainted with him. My answers are correctly recorded herein and I have no vicious habits that I know of and in my opinion his diseases are not due to vicious habits.
