

# DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

TO BE EXECUTED BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR SOME OFFICER THEREOF HAVING CUSTODY OF ITS SEAL.

On this 18<sup>th</sup> day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine  
personally appeared before me, Clerk of the Circuit Court No. 2, a court of  
record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Nathan Johnson aged  
47 years, a resident of the 610 Starling Street in the County of Baltimore  
State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares

that he is the identical Nathan Johnson who was ENROLLED on  
the 26<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1863, in Company "D" of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment  
of U.S.C. Troops commanded by Capt. Thomas McCarty  
and was honorably DISCHARGED at Indianapolis Ind. on the 13<sup>th</sup> day  
of October, 1866; that his personal description is as follows: Age, 47 years; height  
5 feet 10 1/2 inches; complexion, fair; hair, black; eyes, black

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Benedict  
Charles Co, in the State of Maryland on or about the 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of January, 1864, he was carrying poles for the

purpose of building log houses, my mate dropped his  
disc, state fully the causes; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.

and without giving me notice, injuring my back,  
and whilst in line of duty at

Fort Gilmer Va. September 1864. Was taken prisoner by the enemy  
Sent to Libby Prison Va. Whilst so confined was compelled by force to  
assist in building breast works for the enemy from the severe strain  
my back which was weak from the former injury was again injured

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: Rebel Hospital by the enemy  
Angemo, in Richmond Va.  
of treatment.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above Here state what

the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore  
in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been that of a Carman.  
That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when  
enrolled a man. That he is now partially disabled from obtaining his subsistence by  
manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he there-  
fore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Geo W F Vernon  
108 N Canal Street Baltimore Md his true and lawful attorney  
to prosecute his claim. That he has not received or applied for a Pension. That his
