

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

On this 15 day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the county and state aforesaid, Nathan Johnson, who, being duly sworn according to law declares that he is 70 years of age, and a resident of Baltimore County of Maryland, and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Baltimore Md under the name of Nathan Johnson, on the 26 day of September, 1863 as a private, in Co. D. 7th Regt. U.S.C. V.M. 2nd

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore Md, on the 26 day of November, 1864.

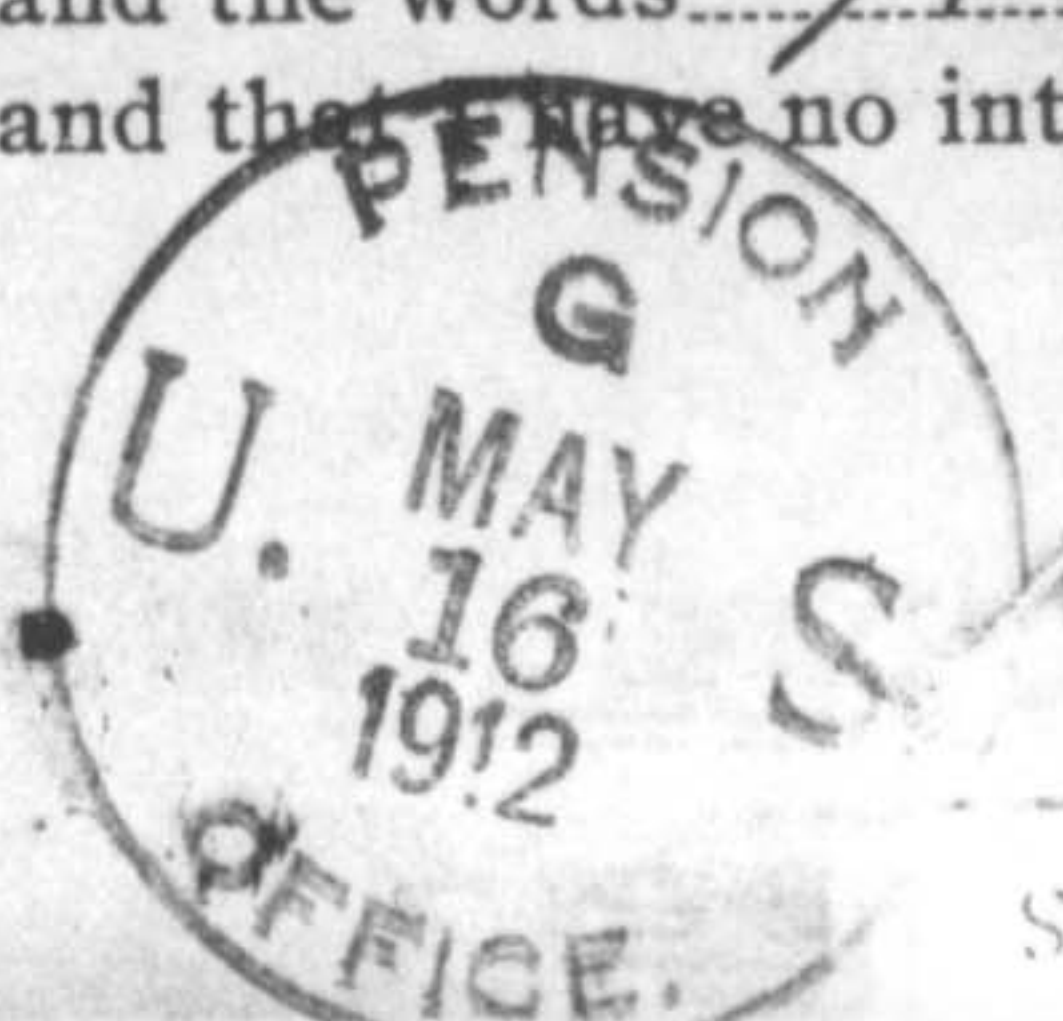
