I further declares that I have no interest in said case and am not concerned in its prosecution.

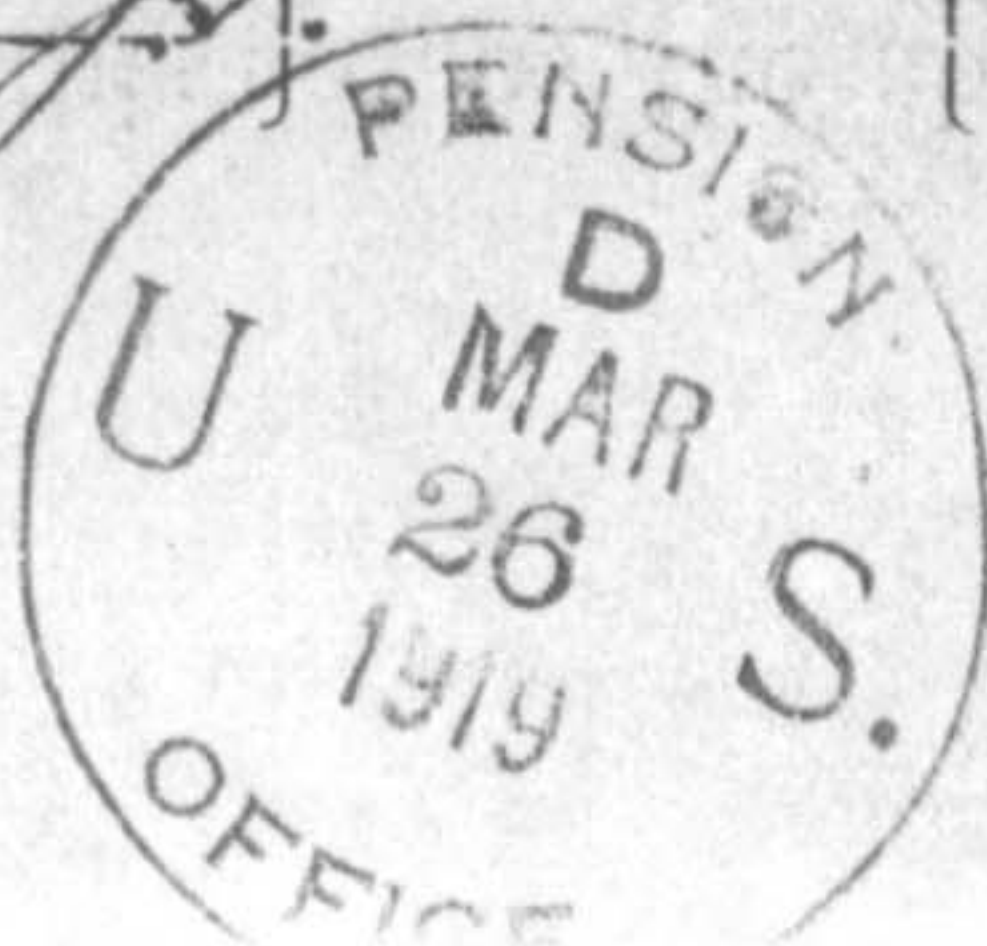
