DEPOSITION *E*Case of *Nathan Johnson*, No. 564795

On this *4* day of *Sept*, 1895, at
Baltimore, County of *Cecil*,
 State of *Md.*, before me, *J. B. Hauler*, a
 Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared *James D.*
Fulks, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer

truly all interrogatories propounded to him during this Special Examination of aforesaid
 pension claim, deposes and says *I am* ^{about} *64* years of age.

Physician, graduate of the University of
Md., this City, class of 1864, reside and
 my City address is 312 Pearl St, Balto. Md.
 I have known this *Clut*, since 1867 or 68
 it was then he called to see me at my office
 seeking treatment for injury to his spine,
 I then examined him and as I now
 remember found that there was
 an injury of his spine, but can't now
 say as to condition of spine at the time
 of that examination. He complained of
 pains in the lumbar spinal region
 extending down one or both thighs,
 more especially his right thigh. I
 then questioned him as to cause and he
 said that while in the Army he
 with another Comrade were carrying
 poles to build quarters, and in
 doing this his Comrade let a pole
 fall from his shoulder & the suddenness
 of the fall & weight of pole caused
 the injury. I saw no signs of scars
 and accepted his theory of the injury.
 I gave treatment then for pains of
 back, and at intervals of from one to
 6 months from 1867 or 68 to 1875 I gave
 him medical treatment for his back

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
