before. I do remember that in 1876
he was there I remember that as
it was the Centennial year and the
Clint, was sent with a team to
Phila. Pa. I cant say how long he had
been there with Mr Stevens before his
going to Phila. I will say that I judge
that I worked with Clint, at teaming
for Mr Stevens for some 5 or 6 years
from 26 years ago. No I have not
worked with him since then, but
