Herewith I have the honor to return the papers in claim #564793 of Nathan Johnson late of "D" 7 U.S.C. Inf. He is now pensioned under the Act of June 27, 1890 at \$6 per month and is claiming additional pension under the general laws on account of injury to back. The claim was referred to the S.E.D. and came here for special examination as to origin and line of duty.

3 I secured Clut. statement and all material testimony known in this district and the same is annexed hereto.

Affiants Jacob Cooper and John Allen are dead, they bore a fair reputation here to truth &c.

The testimony herewith tends to show that Clut. while carrying a log to be used in building quarters for his regiment at Camp near Benedict Md. in the winter of 1863-4 injured his back, slightly, by the log falling from the shoulder.
