Acts of June 27, 1890, and May 9, 1900.

his true and lawful Attorney, to prosecute his claim, and he directs that the sum of Ten Dollars be paid to said Attorney

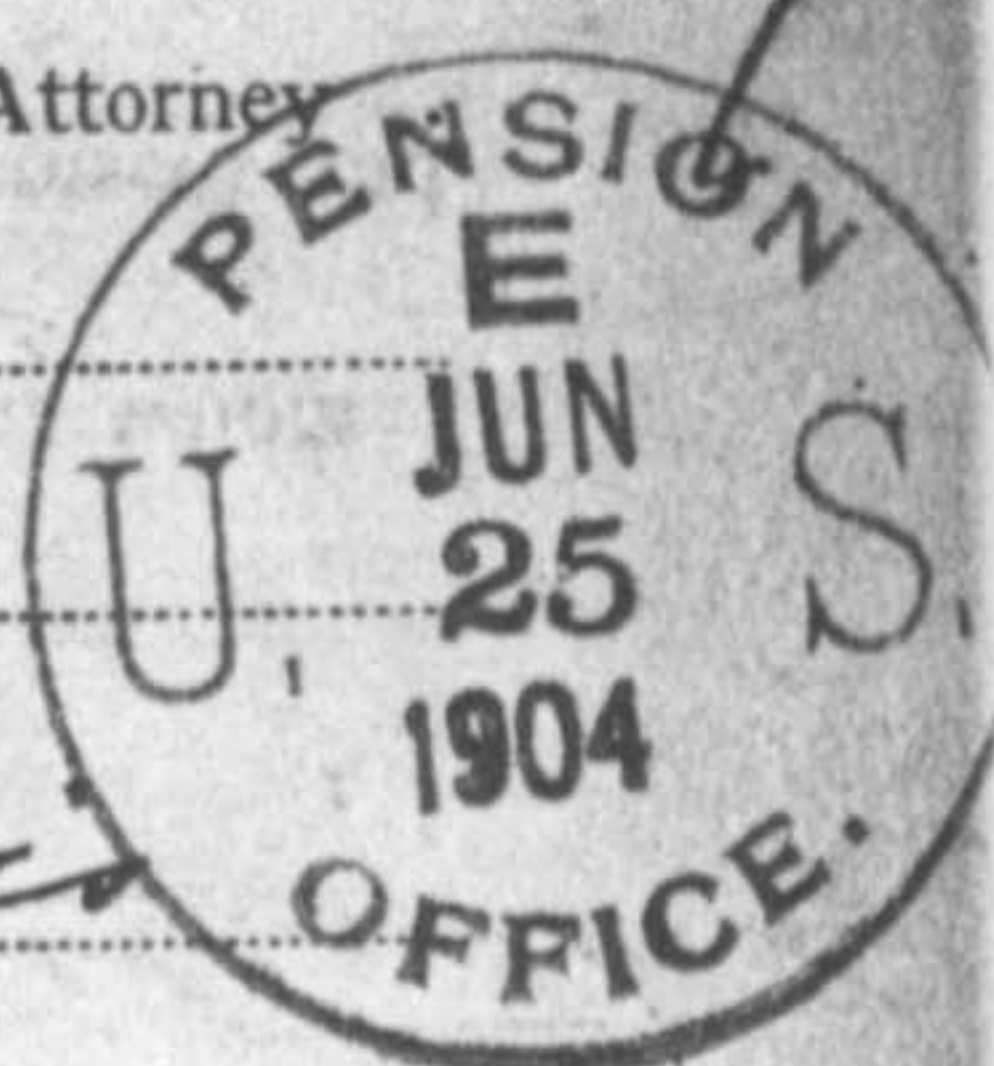
