

Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 23rd day of May, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety

personally appeared before me Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid

aged 52 years, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

John M. Davis, who was ENROLLED as a Private on the 9 day of

October, 1864, in Company H of the 9 regiment of U.S.C.

commanded by Capt. Granville and was honorably DISCHARGED at

Brownsville, Texas, on the — day of October, 1865; That his

personal description is as follows: Age 26 years; height 5 feet 11 inches; complexion brown;

hair black; eyes black. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the

service and in the line of duty at Brownsville, Texas, in the State of Texas,

on or about the — day of July, 1865, he contracted biliousness

from exposure to heat and improper water, and

of wound or injury. (If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.)

at about that time was sunstruck which

affected his eyes making them weak, and caused

vertigo, which complaints have ever since

affected him.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: Only by regimental

surgeon at various times, for sunstroke

and effluvia and biliousness.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the — day of Oct., 1865

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore,

in the State of Maryland, and that his occupation has been that of a teamster

That prior to his entry into the service above-named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a

teamster. That he is now one-half disabled

from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation.
