Claims to have rheumatism in the back, hip and left shoulder
Complains of constant pain in the hips.

States that he suffers severely with neuralgia in the head,
worse on the left side.

Unable to perform manual on account of old age.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 64
respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 8 inches; weight, 158
pounds; age, 62 years. General physical condition below par.

Characteristic appearance of senile debility. Muscles are soft; skin loose and wrinkled.

Rheumatism: Crepitation in left shoulder with pain on manipulation. No deformity of the joints.

Sensitiveness of muscles in the lumbar regions and over the hips; much worse on the right side. Has pain when stooping and is unable to pick objects from the floor without kneeling
Heart, Lungs and Abdominal organs are normal.

There is some tenderness over the supra orbital foramen on the left side.

Probably suffers somewhat with periodical attacks of neuralgia
Claimant would be unable to perform hard manual labor by reason of senile debility.

No other disability exists.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 8/18 rating for the disability caused by Rheumatism for that caused by Senile Debility, and 2/18 for that caused by
