Having had made known to me the nature of this claim I will say that I have no recollection of claimant being affected with any of the diseases you have named. I think I heard him once in service complain of piles but I can't remember where or when. Yes I have made affidavits in this case before. I don't remember what I testified to. Having had shown me my former affidavit I will say I remember claimant was complaining in service but I can't say I recollect the specific disabilities as stated in that affidavit. I have seen a right smart of him since he came out
