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of such a character and sufficient in degree to seriously interfere with his ability to work as there was always danger that he would take a swimming off the head and fall overboard and drown. I really can't give you any idea as to what proportion of his time he was able to work for some days he could work and some days he could not. I don't know of any other disease or disability with which claimant has been affected during the period I have known him. I can't tell you whether or not he has been affected at any time with rheumatism, disease of stomach, heart disease disease of eyes or deafness. My answers are correctly recorded herein.
