On this 30 day of March, 1897, at

 pension claim, deposes and says: I am 49 years old and

 of Harvard Medical School Medical
 Dept of Harvard University. I have
 practiced medicine since 1872
 I know George Green the claimant
 and have known him some
15 or 18 years and have been his
 family physician during that
 period. I have no books accessible
 which would show dates of my treat-
 ment of George Green. He has been
 treated by me for the past ten or
 twelve years for cardiac hypertrophy
 and I attributed the vertigo of the
 head of which he complains to
 the disease of heart. I don't recall
 that I ever was called on to treat
 him for said disability until
 about 12 years ago. I am not
 able to give exact date or fix it near
 and this is given from memory
 only. I have prescribed for him
 pretty nearly every year for the
 same trouble. I advised him not to
 work at his trade as counselor on
