We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Rheumatism, senile debility, heart trouble, vertigo, defect in eyesight and deafness

and that he receives a pension of Eight dollars per month.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for Increase
(Original, increase, restoration, &c.)
I am rheumatism over shoulders and back and shortness of breath after walking - I am deafness of both ears and bad eyesight.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 90; respiration, 22; temperature, 98; height, 5 feet 8 1/2 inches; weight, 140 pounds; age, 69 years. General physical condition below par

Rheumatism - There is rheumatic tenderness of both shoulder joints without atrophy or swelling of muscles or enlargement of joints. There is crepitation with contraction of capsular ligaments, slightly impairing the motion of elevating the arms.

There is also rheumatic tenderness of both hip joints without atrophy or swelling of muscles or enlargement of joints. There is crepitation with contraction of capsular ligaments, creating a limp upon locomotion and requiring the use of a cane.

Senile Debility - There is senile debility present

His nutrition is impaired and his general physical appearance shows ill health

Heart Trouble - The apex beat is one inch to the right and immediately under the left mammary line, plainly evident upon inspection & palpation. Auscultation reveals an increased force of heart's action, together with a systolic murmur, most audible at the 2nd right intercostal space with the stethum, denoting aortic stenosis. There is hypertrophy & dilatation of the left ventricle. There is oedema & dyspnoea but no cyanosis. The pulse striking is 90
