We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Nervous debility and disease of eyes, ears, back and kidneys, head, and neuralgia, and rheumatism.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for INCREASE

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.
Claims to be weak and broken down and unable to work.
Eyesight is bad and is hard of hearing.
Severe pain across the back in region of kidneys with difficulty in stooping and rising. Bad pains through head.
Rheumatism all over the body.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.
 Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 84; respiration, 19; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 4 inches; weight, 136 pounds; age, 69 years. General physical condition is bad. Characteristic appearance of advanced age. Fairly well nourished but tissues are flabby. Skin slightly wrinkled. Has debilitated appearance. Movements are slow. Eyes are normal in appearance. Vision is good for age and proper glass greatly improves. Ears: Membranes are normal. Somewhat hard of hearing but can understand ordinary conversation at a distance of over six feet. Condition due to age. He would be unable to perform hard manual labor and we recommend rating of twelve-eighteenths for senility. No especial evidence of nervous debility. No disease of kidneys. Pain in back due to lumbago. No objective evidence of neuralgia or other affection of head. Rheumatism: Crackling and stiffness with pain on manipulation in all larger joints of the upper and lower extremities. Sensitiveness of muscles in lumbar regions and over the back with pain and stiffness on all motions of body. Has difficulty in stooping to pick objects from the floor and in regaining the erect position. Movements are slow and stiff. No enlargement or other deformity of joints or limitation of motion. Claimant is suffering with chronic rheumatism aggravated by results of old age and we recommend rating of eight-eighteenths for rheumatism and results. Heart, lungs and abdominal organs are normal for age. No other disability exists.

Rate for EACH cause of disability. He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 8/18 rating for the disability caused by Rheumatism for that caused by Senility and 12/18 for that caused by
