Hamilton's Company, (A.) of the Ninth Regiment of the United States Cold Troops was enlisted by Col Birney of the Benedict Md Regiment of Benedict Md at Benedict Md on the thirty first day of October, 1863, to serve three years; he was born in Somerset in the State of Maryland, is twenty years of age, five feet six 3/4 inches high, Dark complexion, Black eyes, Black hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Farmer. During the last two months said soldier has been unfit for duty 60 days.*

He states he was wounded in action at Fort Harrison Va. Sept. 29-1864
