

# Declaration for Invalid Pension.

Act of June 27, 1890.

NOTE.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of Clerk of Court is not necessary. If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS sixth day of April - ....., A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety two

personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace - .....

..... in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at David Island, Md Harbor on the 31<sup>st</sup> .....
