After my discharge I resided at Bucktown Dorchester Co Md remained till 1868 then removed to Stiles Street bet Central Ave and Gough St remained till 1870 then removed to Chappel Street bet Fayette and Hampstead Sts remained till 1874 then removed to Mulliken St one door from Ann remained till 1876 then removed to 1504 Mulliken St lived there up to date 1890 all above are in Baltimore. My occupation is light writing when able from my discharge to present time. My disability is Rheumatism which I contracted at Fortress Monroe Va and bet Washington and Bladensburg in Feb or March 1866 while encamped at Fort Lincoln bet Washington & Bladensburg had an attack of Paralysis of right side of face and body and have been a sufferer ever since.
