This certifies that I have known

tended him several times for Rheumatism
which he claims to have acquired in the

him for an abscess of the breast resulting
from pressure, caused by the strap of Knief-
sack, which first caused a tumor, which resulted in an
abscess & necrosis of the breast bone. These complaints
seriously interfere with his ability to perform
any work & he is almost totally disabled.

I further declare that I have no interest in said case, and am not concerned in
its prosecution.
