that while encamped near Yorktown Va
the said Chase was suffering from
severe pains in his breast, to such an
extent that I excused him from duty and
finally sent him to hospital, After
which he never returned to the Command
I have met the Claimant John Chase
several times since my discharge in
1866. And he still complains of misery
in his breast. Which he states was caused
by forced marches and carrying of his
knapsack

I further declare that I have no interest in said case, and Am not concerned in
its prosecution.
