BE IT REMEMBERED, that on this 27th day of October

A. D. 1890, before me, the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace of the said State, in and for the city aforesaid, personally appeared George Afford & Perry Pinkney members of Company A. 4. Maryland Col. Infantry and made oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God, that John Chase the applicant for Pension was a Private in Company A. of the 4 Maryland Colored Infantry. Contracted a severe cold sometime in the winter of 1864 while encamped at York Town in the State of Virginia which left him with Rheumatism and Pain in his Chest and almost disabled him. So much so that he was unfit for duty at least half his time but was compelled to struggle along as best he could and was finally sent to the hospital some time in June or July 1865 when we lost sight of him.
