Sir:

In the above cited claim, the claimant should state the full and correct christian name of her former husband, Johnson, as the name appears in the case as James and as James H. She should also state, under oath, whether he served in the army or navy of the United States; and if so, the full designation of his service and whether a claim for pension was ever filed on account thereof.

There is further required testimony of witnesses having personal knowledge, showing whether the claimant has remarried since the soldier's death.

Do not fail to inscribe upon each piece of evidence filed the name and service of the soldier and the number of this claim.
