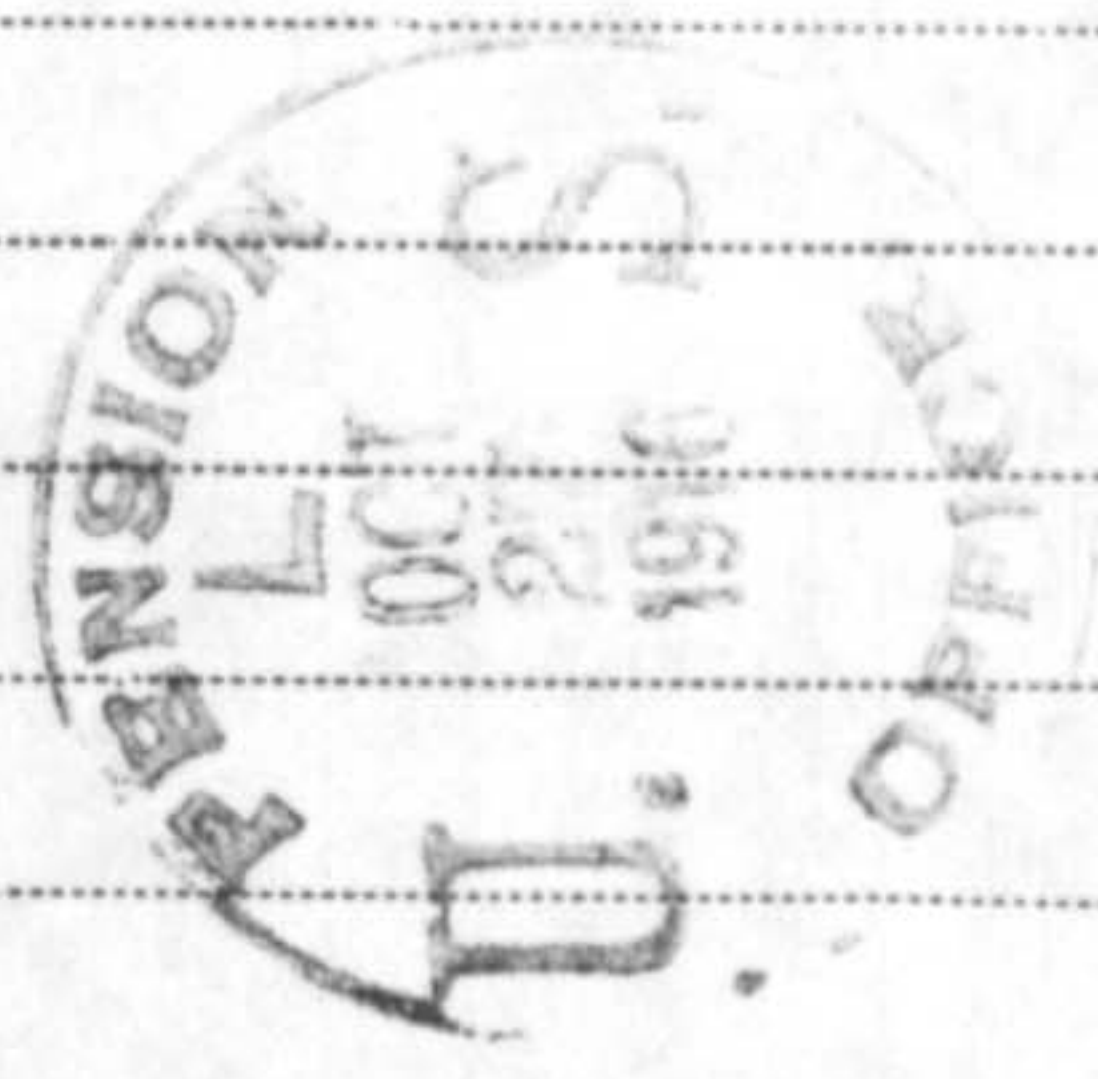


Claim No. 1071785 of ^{widow of} *Jarrett Brown* Co. A, 19th Reg't. U.S.C.T.
