No. 689404 under Act June 27, 1890, by reason of disability from rheumatism. That he served in Co. A. 99th. Regt. U. S. Cold. Inf. Vols. in the Military service of the United State during the War of the Rebellion. That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension, under Act June 27, 1890, on account of increased disability from rheumatism, also on account of disability from disease of heart, lamago, kidney disease, partial loss of up-sight of both eyes, rupture of right side. That he appoints George S. Pooker of City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That his Post Office address is 526 N. Dallas St. Baltimore Md.
