 misery in his side - I think
 it was the doctor from the
 Dispensary on Centre St & Bal-
 timore St. that I saw attending him.
 His wife was not living with
 him when he died. Don't know
 how long they were separated
 or cause of separation. and
 Loney saw her once, that was
 the day of the funeral.
 I remember that I made an
 affidavit in this case some
 time before John Devereux died
 I have heard you read the affida-
 vit signed by me but I know
 nothing of him having deposed
 his
