sick since Post Hooper, since
Aug. 17, 1865, Feb. 28 '66,
sick at Post Hooper, present
since since Aug. 17, 1865.

The medical records show him treated as
follows as *John Damsell*
Jan. 22, 1864, U. S. Army
to April 9, 66 (our diagnosis)
not to duty
nothing additional found.
