

Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 26 day of May A. D. one thousand eight hundred and 90

personally appeared before me a Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court, a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid John Duncan,

aged 40 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

John Duncan who was ENROLLED as a private on the — day of

Spring, 1863, in Company D of the 19 regiment of U. S. C. T.

commanded by Capt. Mix and was honorably DISCHARGED at

Baltimore, Md. on the — day of Nov., 1866 That his

personal description is as follows: Age 18 years; height 5 feet 5 inches; complexion brown;

hair black; eyes brown. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the

service and in the line of duty at Brownsville in the State of Texas,

on or about the — day of summer, 1866, he contracted chamber,

since discharging all these disabilities have ever

farmer. That he is now three-fourths disabled

from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of

the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid

pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has not received nor applied for

a pension; that his residence is No. 517 North Spring street

Baltimore, Md. and that his post office address is

the same.
