address is 224 Bethel St., Baltimore Md. and

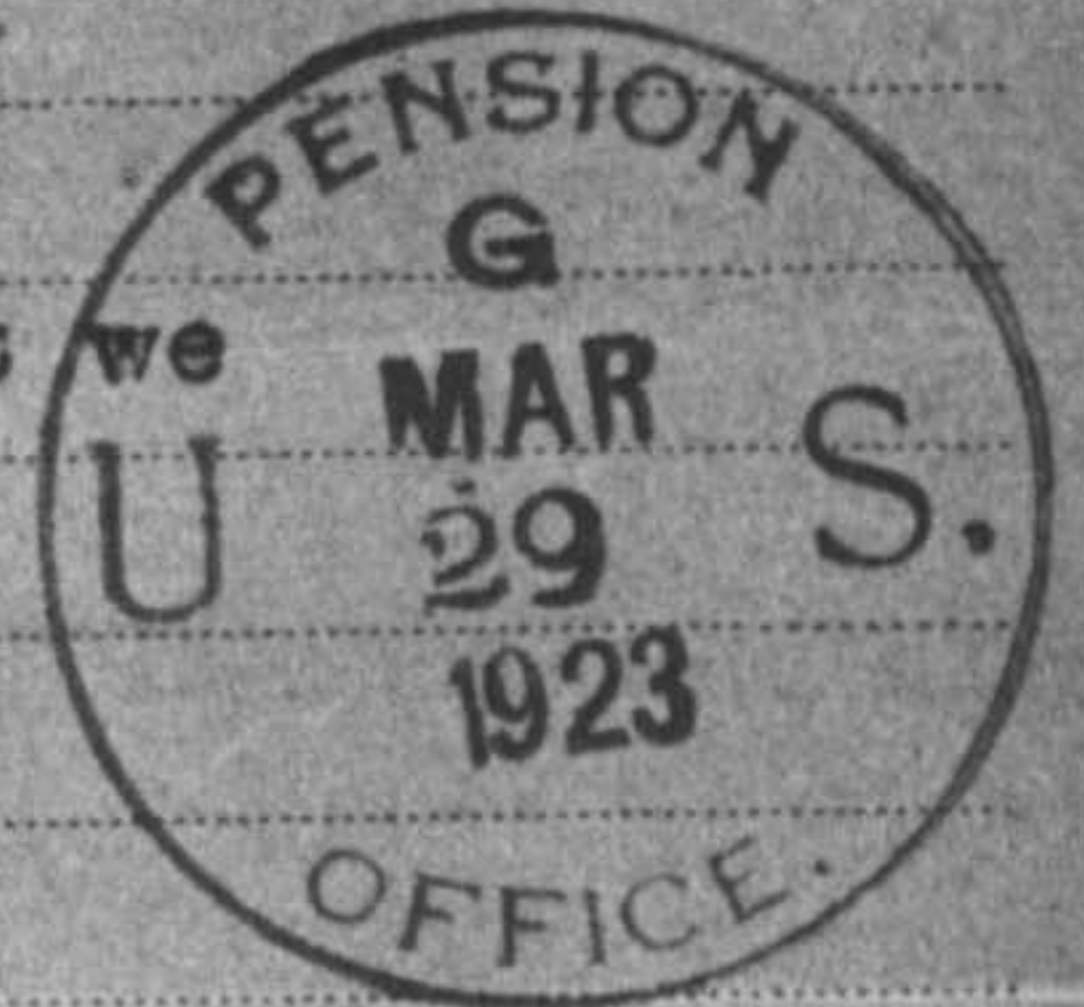
Mary L. Stafford, aged 76 years, whose Post Office

Our knowledge of the above matter is from the fact that we are sister-in-laws of the above named applicant.



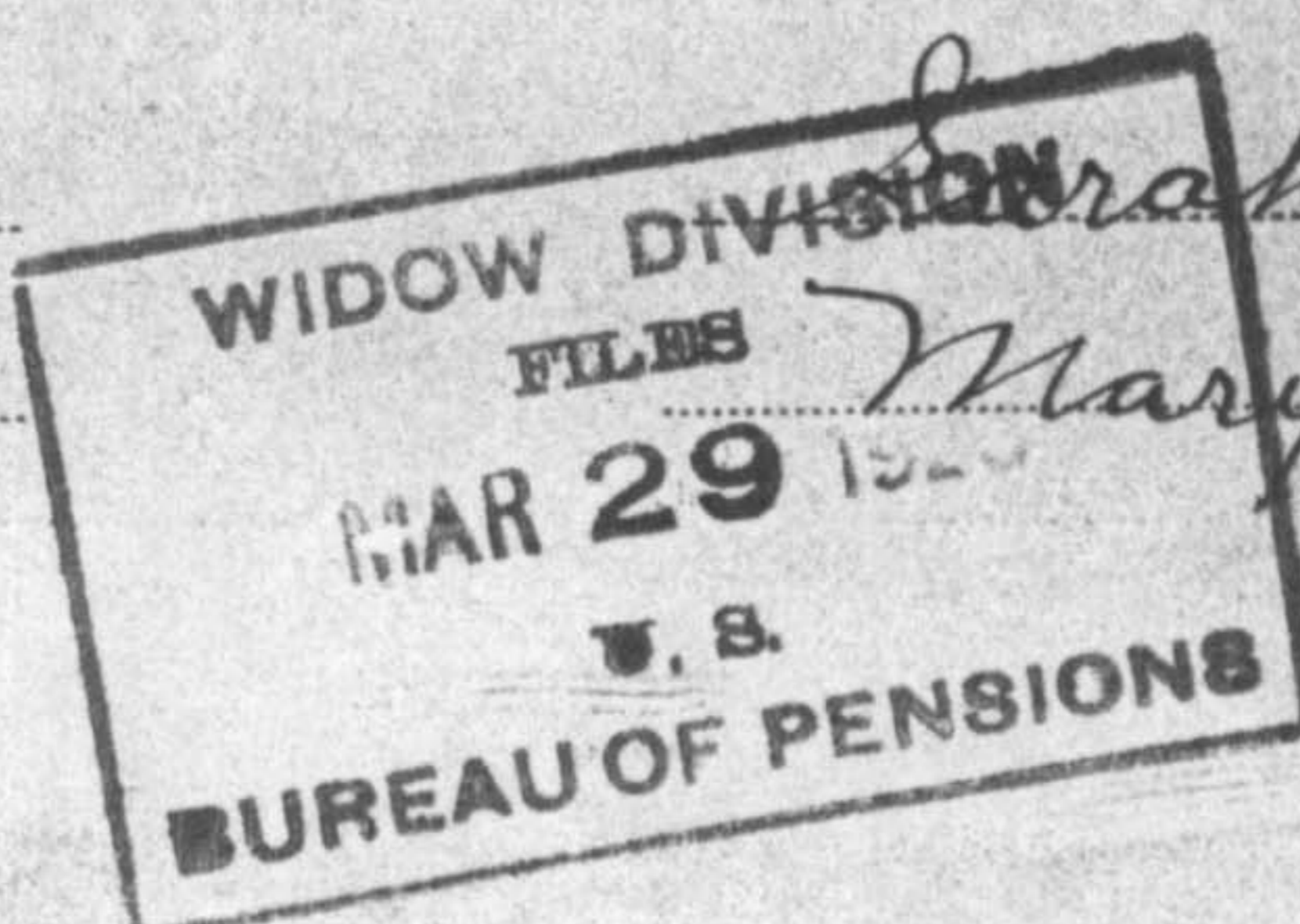
