*Shingles, mumps, weak back; disease of eyes & vertigo & other more injury to my hand & ankle, the latter incurred in Bull Run, Georgia, all in the service and line of duty.*

I know these facts from my personal intimacy with him at the time of the incurrance of the said disabilities and know from personal observation of his symptoms that he suffered from same during rest of the time we were together."
