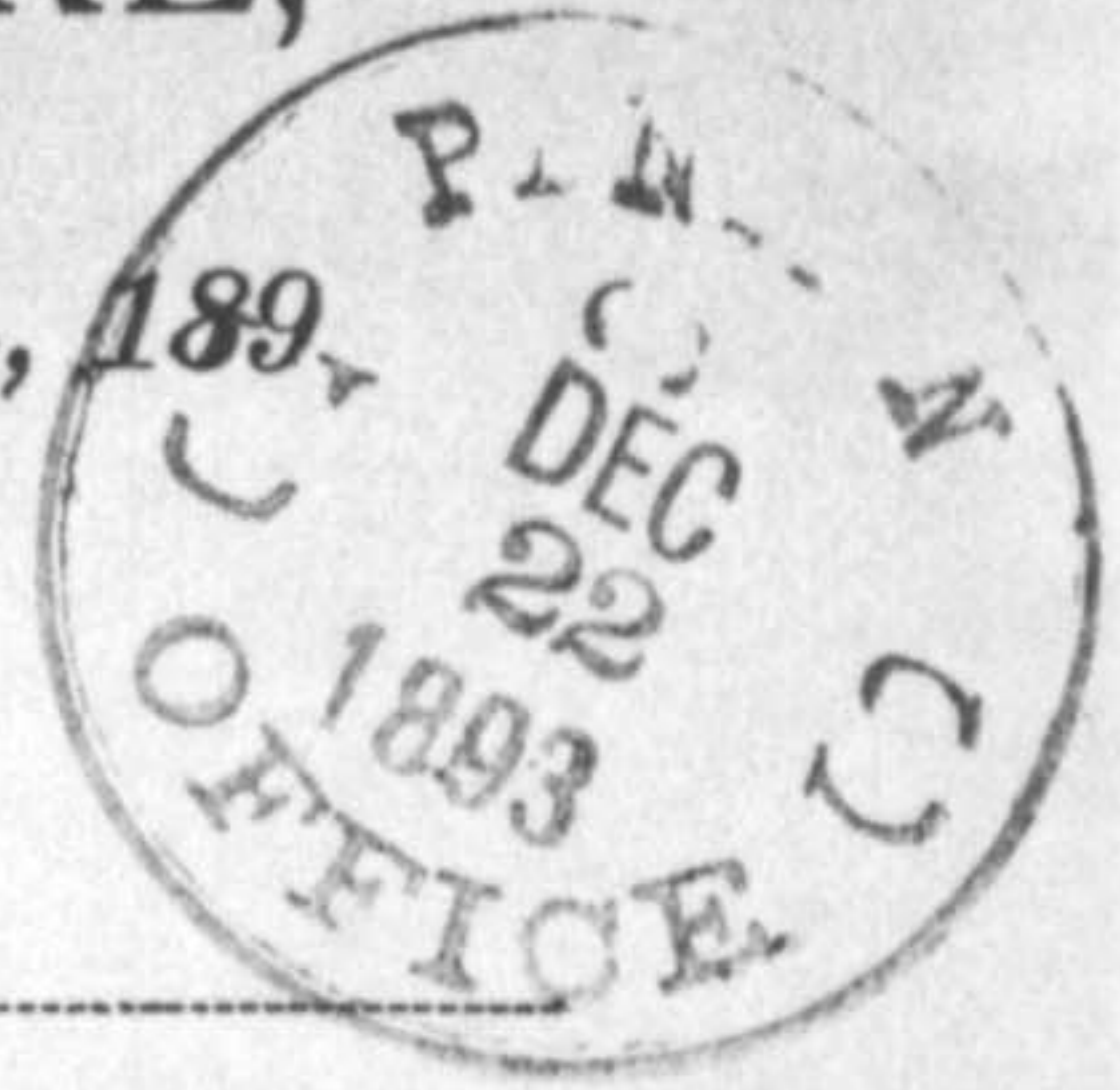

IN THE CRIMINAL COURT OF BALTIMORE,

Term, 1893



The Petition of Addie Seymour
respectfully represents to this Honorable Court, that Charles Seymour
of said city, aged fifty years, and ~~residing with~~ now at
Bayview Asylum

is a Lunatic or Insane Pauper within the provision of Article 59 of the Code of Public General Laws; that the said Charles Seymour is not possessed in his own right, of any property, real or personal, or entitled to the use of any property by last will and testament, or deed of trust for his use or benefit; and that the said Charles Seymour has no parent whose property is actually assessed to one thousand dollars; and your petitioner therefore prays that this Honorable Court will cause a Jury of twelve good and lawful men to be empanelled forthwith, and charged to inquire whether the said Charles Seymour is insane or lunatic; and that such order may be made in the premises as to this Court may seem proper.

A jury of twelve lawful men having been empanelled, sworn and charged at the bar of this Court to enquire whether the said Charles Seymour is insane or lunatic; and the said jury having filed in Court here an inquisition declaring that the said Charles Seymour is insane or lunatic; and it appearing to the Court that the said Charles Seymour is a lunatic pauper, within the provisions of Article 59 of the Code of Public General Laws—

It is Hereby Ordered by the Court here, on this fourteenth day of December 1893 that the said Charles Seymour be sent to Bayview Asylum

there to be confined at the expense of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, until shall have recovered and been discharged in due course of law. nothing in this order to prevent the wife or other relations of said lunatic from confining him or providing for his comfort under Section 1 Article 59 Code of Public General Laws of Maryland
