Private Henry Bent of Co. K. of that regiment, enrolled Jan'y 11. 1864 at St. Marys, Md. is reported on Org. Roll of that Co. dated at Benedict, Md. Jan'y 16. 1864 present and on muster rolls for March & April and to Oct 31. 64. "Absent sick since March 10/64 at McKim's Mannon's Hoopl. Baltimore Md." muster roll from Org to Feb'y 29/64, not on file.

Regl. Returns for Jan'y and Feb'y 64 do not report them absent; March 64, incomplete; May 64 "Cooper" absent without leave since May 5/64; July and Sept 64 do not report Cooper - Co and Regl records do not report Cooper absent in March 65, nor show date of his return to duty from "Abs without leave May 5/65" The Companies moved from Annapolis to Baltimore Md. Mich 2/64, Embarked from there for Annapolis Md. Apr 19/64; Marched for the Army of the Potomac April 24/64, crossing the Rapidan May 6; Near at Prince Georges C. H. June 30th in action at Petersburg Va July 30 and stationed near Petersburg to Oct. 31/64.
