

affiant was wounded in the left temple
in a short time after leaving said Bene-
dict encampment and was sent to
McKim Mansion Hospital Baltimore
City Md at which latter place he found
said Henry Johnson under treatment
for the aforesaid sickness and when
he left him still sick when affiant
was discharged therefrom and sent
to his command for duty a few months
after being sent there; and he further says
that when he came to Baltimore in the fall
of 1867 immediately after being discharged
from service he found said Johnson and
went to boarding with him and wife Me-
lia and continued with them for three years
and in all of this time said Henry suffered
more or less with a cough and contin-
ued to suffer there from up until his death
therefrom. That his knowledge as stated was
obtained by personal observation thereof as a
fellow workman and friend at Benedict and as
such continuously up to the time of his death
that he has no interest in the prosecuting said claim
