 was considered a sound healthy
 man prior to his enlistment in
 the army. I don't think he then
 had anything trouble or cough.

He was a very good worker and
 I never heard of consumption being
 in the family. I have not seen
 Henry Johnson since his enlistment
 in the army, but have heard he
 lived in Baltimore.
