The apt. that I was ruptured in my
"left" groin is incorrect, It is my right
one, No. I never got any treatment for Rheum or Rupture.

I lived with Dr. Samuel Earle, Balto. along in 1840-1-2-3.

I have understood your questions & my answers
are correctly recorded.

The only sickness I had was when
I had the Mumps -
