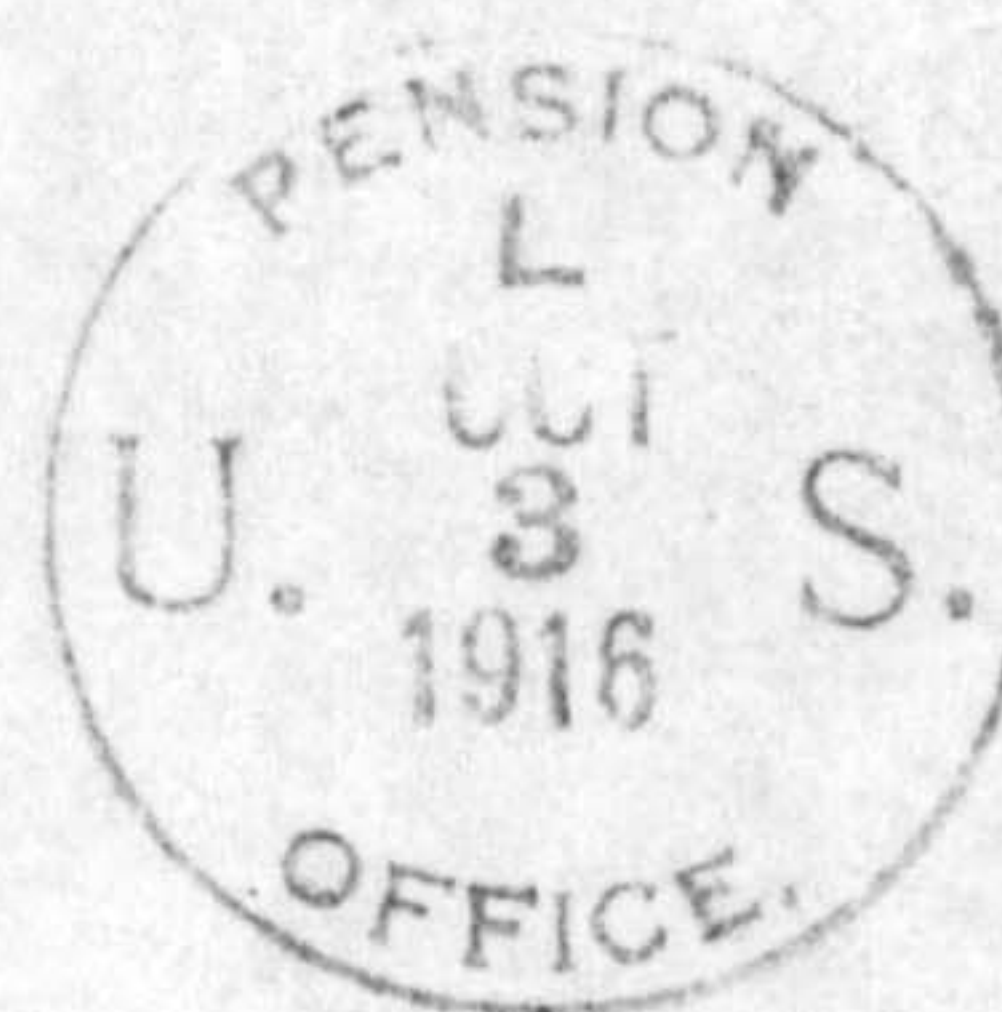
Sir:

In the above-cited claim for pension the claimant alleges that the soldier died June 29, 1916, whereas the copy of the public record on file shows that he died June 24, 1916. This discrepancy should be explained, under oath or seal, by the party in error, and the correct date of soldier's death established.

Each piece of evidence filed should have inscribed thereon the name of the claimant, the name and service of the soldier, and the number of the claim.
