Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of too low rating for his

which he also claims pension debility from age

Name or describe each additional disability, if any, not heretofore alleged.

belief permanent. He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution, MILO B. STEVENS
& CO., of WASHINGTON D.C. their successors and legal representatives, his true
and lawful attorneys, to present and prosecute his claim, requesting that, in the event of the
allowance of the same, his said attorneys be paid the fee now provided by law.
