

DECLARATION FOR ADDITIONAL INVALID PENSION.
(OLD AND NEW DISABILITY.)

Under an act granting PENSIONS to SOLDIERS and SAILORS who are incapacitated for the performance of manual labor and providing for PENSIONS to WIDOWS, MINOR CHILDREN and DEPENDENT PARENTS.

On this 18th day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety five, personally appeared before me, Alfred Tucker, a Justice of the Peace, within and for the County and State aforesaid, James Taylor, aged fifty five years, a resident of Centreville, County of Queen Anne, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States under the Act of Congress approved June 27, 1890, by Certificate number 887.349, and duly enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency, at the rate of Six dollars per month, having served in the military service of the United States H. 39 Regt.; U.S. Army (State whether military or naval.) that his present physical condition is such that he believes himself entitled to receive an increased rate for his pensioned disabilities,

Application is also hereby made for additional pension by reason of the following-named ~~disabilities~~ disabilities ~~for which he is not pensioned~~, sunstroke, rheumatism, rupture and fibroid tumor

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are, to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent, and that he is thereby disabled from earning a support. That he served at least ninety days and was honorably DISCHARGED on the 4 day of Dec, 1865. That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as heretofore stated. Has or has not.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,
