 who, being duly sworn, declares in relation to the aforesaid case, as follows:

I was first affected with mumps in front of
Potomac bay about Sept 1864 which I believe was the
cause of my rupture, having had to make a
long march while I was suffering with mumps
there being no ambulances for me I had to
struggle on that march of ten days.

I was taken with Rheumatism about October
of same year while doing Garrison duty
about James River, Va. both of the above
disabilities I have had ever since

In regard to Fibroid Tumor which was found out on
my last examination I can't say much. all I can

say is, I am affected as I was in the beginning, except
getting worse each year.
I never had any previous hurt
been always a good man.
