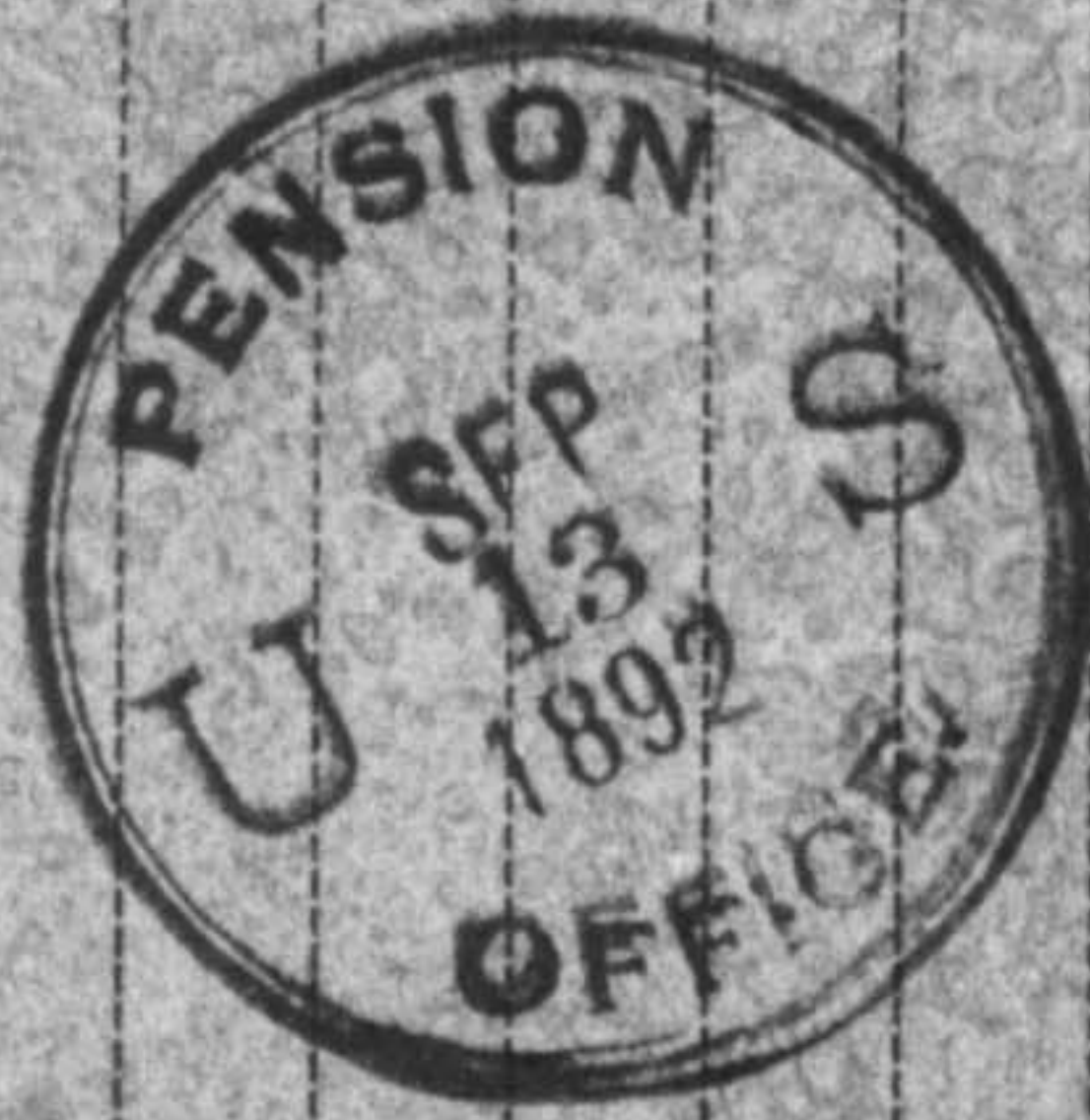
From March 31, 1864, to Feb. 28, 1865
