Claims to have pains through the arms and legs and right side with pain when walking. Unable to perform manual labor as result.

Complains of roaring in the head.

Eyes are weak and vision is impaired.

Has pains across the back in the region of the kidneys.

Makes no claim for paralysis.

Here give a full description of the disability, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 62, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 3 inches; weight, 122 pounds; age, 47 years. General physical condition fair. No evidence whatever of paralysis or disease of the nervous system.

No affection of the head. Special senses are good.

Eyes are normal in appearance. Vision 20-30.

Ears: Membranes are normal. Hearing good.

No disease of the kidneys. Urine is normal.

Rheumatism: Slight crepitation in all the large joints of upper and lower extremities with pain on manipulation. No deformity of the joints.

Sensitiveness of muscles in the lumbar regions and about the hip joints with pain on stooping and walking and has difficulty in picking objects from the floor.

Heart: Apex in normal position. Action regular and strong.

There is a murmur systolic in character heard over the second costo-sternal articulation, immediately preceding the second sound of the heart.

Evidently a slight stenosis, but not sufficient to cause a disability.

Lungs and Abdominal organs are normal.

This man is suffering with rheumatism, which is his only disability.

No other disability exists.
