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married, shown. If the soldier was married also to Julia, the death of said Julia should be shown.

The records of the War Department show that the soldier was 19 years old when he enlisted in 1864, and he would have been, therefore, 57 years old when he died in 1902, but the transcript of the death record furnished by the claimant shows the death of a man 45 years old.

There should be furnished the testimony of credible witnesses who knew the soldier in the service showing that he is the identical man who died August 8, 1902, in whose behalf the claimant claims pension.
