

Act of June 27, 1890.
Widow's Declaration for Pensions.

This Must be Sworn to Before a Court of Record or Some Officer Thereof Having Custody of the seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore - ss:

ON THIS 11th day of June A. D., one thousand eight hundred and ninety five, personally appeared before me a Justice of the Peace of the

Mary J. Kingee, a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid, aged 43 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain the pension provided by Act of Congress granting pension to widows; that she is the widow of Robert Kingee -

who enlisted under the name of Robert Kingee

at Balto Md. on the 19th day of

Decr - A. D., 1863, in Co B 49th U. S. Col'd Troops.
(Company and Regiment of service, if in the army; or vessel and rank

if in the navy.) , in the war of the rebellion, and was honorably discharged at Brownsville

Texas - on the Jan 15th day of 1867.

and who died at Co B 49th U. S. Col'd Troops on the 7th day of

June - 1895.

That she was married under the name of Mary J. Bond - to said

Robert Kingee on the 21st day of October

A. D., 1875, by Rev Wm Adams - at Balto Md.

there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that ~~neither she nor her husband~~ ^{one} had been previously

married but she had not been married before - that she

(If either have been previously married, so state, giving date of death or divorce of former spouse.)

has to present date remained his widow; that the following are the names and dates of birth of all his legitimate children yet surviving, who were under sixteen years of age at date of father's death, viz:

That she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or maintenance.

(For such children as are not under her care, claimant should account.)

That she has no other means of support than her daily labor; that she has not heretofore made application which was numbered _____; That she hereby appoints with full power of substitution and
